Its products therefore convey a genuine philosophy which endows them with richness, rarity and history.








# MATTHEW NORMAN: A TALE OF TIME AND CRAFTSMANSHIP

Step into a mesmerizing voyage through time, back to the year 1871, when Henri Sandoz kindled the flame of a legendary watchmaking legacy. Nestled in the heart of the Swiss Jura, in the enchanting town of Le Locle, Sandoz laid the cornerstone of his horological empire - Henry Sandoz & Cie. In a harmonious melding of talents, Proteca and Goldman intertwined their destinies in 1974, giving birth to the hallowed entity we now know as Matthew Norman Clockmakers AG. Inspired by the ageless allure of carriage clocks, Matthew Norman embarked on a creative odyssey, breathing life into collections that emanated classical charm, each tick a testament to their dedication.

### A MASTERPIECE IN THE ART OF SWISSCLOCKMAKING
















#### DIAPHANE IN BLUE

The Wind clock from Matthew Norman is a 18 jewel beauty with an 8 day power reserve, and a signature mechanical movement. The weight of its intense lines around the sides give the center gears the impression of floating, while the heart of the clock displays a strong contrast between the plates incorporating the skeletonized dial and the coated gear chain.

#### USEFUL INFORMATIONS



Each clock is assembled in our Manufacture in Delémont, Swiss Jura by our Master watchmakers, and is equipped with an inhouse mechanical movement, made out of over 300 components. Our mechanical movements meet the highest Swiss quality standard.

Our clocks are developped to ensure optimal accuracy and reliability. It is well accepted for a mechanical clock to have a few seconds' variation per day and our clocks are set so as not to delay. However if you should note a wider variation, please contact an authorized dealer that will advise you, or a Matthew Norman technical support center which will proceed with the necessary adjustment.

#### **MAINTENANCE**

Our products have a long life span and will give you great satisfaction as long as they receive the appropriate care.

To be kept in good working condition, it is recommended to periodically service your clock. We therefore advise to have the movement overhauled every 5 years.
